greatly appreciated. We love it when you come to visit us.






School Closure Day

I have asked the YMCA about the possibility of having child care provided at the school to cater and support those families who find it difficult to find child care. I will be raising this issue with the Parent Advisory Board next Wednesday and will inform you of future developments in this area.

What is the difference between Numeracy and Mathematics?



times the terms Numeracy and Mathematics are used interchangeably. Numeracy is not a synonym for mathematics, but the two are clearly interrelated. All numeracy is underpinned by some mathematics; hence school mathematics has an important role in the development of young people's numeracy. The implemented mathematics curriculum (i.e. what happens in schools) has a responsibility for introducing and developing mathematical concepts which underpin numeracy. Numeracy involves using mathematics to achieve a purpose in a particular context. To be numerate is to have the competence and confidence to use mathematics effectively to meet the general demands of life at home, school, in paid work, and for participation in community and civic life.

Learning mathematics in school is also about learning in the discipline – its structure, beauty and importance in our cultures. Further, while knowledge of mathematics is necessary for numeracy, having that knowledge is not in itself sufficient to ensure that learners become numerate.


This week's LEARNING FOCUS is
