We celebrate the Feast of Jesus' Ascension into heaven this Sunday. Traditionally the As-

cension is celebrated 40 days after Easter. The Ascension is one of the five major milestones found in the Gospel of the life of Jesus, the others being Baptism, Transfiguration. Crucifixion ad Resurrection.

At the end of his Gospel, St Luke gives a very concise account of the event of the Ascension.

Jesus led his disciples "out as far as Bethany, and lifting up his hands he blessed them. While he blessed them, he parted from them, and was carried up into heaven. And they worshipped him, and returned to Jerusalem with great joy, and were continually in the temple blessing God" (Lk 24:50-53).



'The Ascension of Jesus into heaven acquaints us with this deeply consoling reality on our journey: In Christ, true God and true man, our humani-

Christ opened the path to us. He is like a roped guide climbing a mountain who, on reaching the summit, pulls us up to him and leads us to God.

If we entrust our life to him, if we let ourselves be guided by him, we are certain to be in safe hands, in the hands of our Saviour, of our Advocate.'




In Year 2M and 2N the focus this term is on SCIENCE and DESIGN. Looks like they are having a great deal of fun as they are learning!



If students are in Years 3 to 6, they will need to enter the books they have read online themselves. If students are in Foundation to Year 2, we ask you or an older sibling to register read books online. If no one in your family can do this then I will do it for you.

I strongly suggest that you join the local public library (free – no cost!), 301 Hampshire Road, Sunshine. You will also be able to borrow books on the reading list from our school library. The school library is open for borrowing every morning before school (except Fridays) and during your child's class set library time. We ask

you to take good care of all our school books as we have lost a number of books in the past.
We hope that many students will participate in the Premiers' Reading Challenge this year and enjoy the journey!
The Challenge closes on 9 September.
