This year on the 19th of March the Sisters of St Joseph will be celebrating the 150th Anniversary of the founding of their Congregation by St Mary of the Cross MacKillop and Father Julian Tenison Woods. We at Our Lady's School give thanks to the Sisters of St Joseph for their 73 years of service in both our parish and school. We maintain our strong ties with the Sisters and are committed to keep the charism of St Mary of the Cross MacKillop alive in our school.



As a way to celebrate this important 150th anniversary we would like to raise some very much needed money for 'Joseph's Corner' which is a not for profit support service for families dealing with alcohol and drug addiction. The Sisters of St Joseph began 'Joseph's Corner' in 2001 and rely on donations to keep the services going. The aim of Joseph's corner is to:

- Provide appropriate ongoing support service, to enable families to cope and manage their difficult situation.

The guest speaker is Susan McLean. Susan is Australia's foremost expert in the area of cyber safety and young people and was a member of Victoria Police for 27 years. Widely known as the 'cyber cop', she was the first Victoria Police Officer appointed to a position involving cyber safety and young people. In 2003 she was the Victoria Police Region Four Youth Officer of the Year. She has also been awarded The National Medal and the Victoria Police Service Medal and 2nd Clasp.

She has conducted extensive research and has completed advanced training in both the USA and the UK. She has been an advisor to schools, elite sporting bodies and both State and Federal Governments. Susan will allow time during her presentation to answer all your questions so please do not miss out on this opportunity to learn more about the technology that has become a part of our daily lives.


# Parents, children and staff having fun at our wonderful Foundation Barbeque Evening Celebrating Together as a School Community



**5th Sunday of Lent, Year C**

Jesus reminds us that we all are in need of forgiveness and asks us to sin no more. How can we show God's forgiveness to others?



**Gospel**

**Jn 8:1-11**

Jesus went to the Mount of Olives. At daybreak he appeared in the Temple again; and as all the people came to him, he sat down and began to teach them.

The scribes and Pharisees brought a woman along who had been caught committing adultery; and making her stand there in full view of everybody, they said to Jesus. 'Master, this woman was caught in the very act of committing adultery, and Moses has ordered us in the Law to condemn women like this to death by stoning. What have you to say?' They asked him this as a test, looking for something to use against him. But Jesus bent down and started writing on the ground with his finger. As they persisted with their question, he looked up and said, 'If there is one of you who has not sinned, let him be the first to throw a stone at her.' Then he bent down and wrote on the ground again. When they heard this they went away one by one, beginning with the eldest, until Jesus was left alone with the woman, who remained standing there. He looked up and said, 'Woman, where are they? Has no one condemned you?' 'No one, sir,' she replied. 'Neither do I condemn you,' said Jesus 'go away, and don't sin any more.'

During this final week of Lent we can all work really hard at being the best Christians we can be, in preparation for Holy Week.
