Dear Parents,

We are approaching the end of the school year, and also the end of the Church's liturgical year. Advent is almost upon us. The end of the year is a very busy time for us all, however Advent calls us to make time for quiet reflection and prayer, to open our heart and mind and spirit to the knowledge that God loves us and invites us to share that love with others. It is a time to reflect on how well we have responded to that invitation as individuals and as a community, and to renew our commitment to be God's love in the world.

One of the most popular symbols for Advent is the Advent wreath. The Advent wreath of evergreens decorated with candles was a symbol in northern Europe long before the arrival of Christianity. The circle symbolizes the love of God which has no beginning and no end while the evergreens and lighted candles signify the persistence of life in the midst of winter.

In Catholic churches, the most popular colours for the Advent candles are violet, and rose, corresponding with the colours of the liturgical vestments for the Sun-

days of Advent.


School Times in 2017









Story Time



Stay Awake! Be Ready!

First Sunday of Advent, Year A

Gospe Mt 24:37-44

Jesus said to his disciples: 'As it was in Noah's day, so will it be when the Son of Man comes. For in those days before the Flood people were eating, drinking, taking wives, taking husbands, right up to the day Noah went into the ark, and they suspected nothing till the Flood came and swept all away. It will be like this when the Son of Man comes. Then of two men in the fields one is taken, one left; of two women at the millstone grinding, one is taken, one left.

'So stay awake, because you do not know the day when your master is coming. You may be quite sure of this that if the householder had known at what time of the night the burglar would come, he would have stayed awake and would not have allowed anyone to break through the wall of his house. Therefore, you too must stand ready because the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect.'

During the season of Advent we prepare for the arrival of Jesus. What are three things you can do to be ready for Jesus during this first week of Advent?		

Help Noah and the animals find their way onto the ark so they can be ready for the flood when it comes.
