On Monday the 8th of December we will be celebrating the Feast Day of Our Lady of the Immaculate Conception which is the name of our wonderful school and parish. This is a day of





Parent Voice in Action


Thank you to all the parents who filled in the swimming survey on the Skoolbag app or from the classroom sites. We welcome your feedback and will use it to inform decisions made in relation to the 2017 swimming program.

Here are the results which show an overwhelming support for the swimming program to remain as it is. We did have three comments suggesting a staggered approach rather than the intensive consecutive ten day approach we have at the moment. We know children learn best when they can practice their skills on a daily basis rather than once a week where strategies and techniques can often be forgotten and then have to be re-taught. The intensive approach also assists children to build up their confidence in the water.


In 2017, would you like to see a ten day swimming program or a five day swimming program?

Our Lady's TECHNOLOGY update

At Our Lady's, we are always evaluating our devices and technology and looking for opportunities to upgrade and maximise the coverage and opportunities that we offer our students.

Recently, we purchased 30 Acer Chromebooks and a charging cabinet. A Chromebook is a small laptop, very lightweight and handy. It is essentially a Google product - meaning, that once the lid is opened it is ready to login to a Google account and access all the Google Apps. Currently the year 4-6 students are trialling the Chromebooks in their classrooms. The feedback has been very positive!

We are now looking at upgrading all our interactive projectors and boards, across the whole school. We have had fully integrated whiteboards in our rooms for over 13 years now! Our new devices and projectors will be installed very early in 2017 - we will keep you posted about this!



At each bend in the road write down something that you are sorry for doing.


Gospe Mt 3:1-12

In due course John the Baptist appeared; he preached in the wilderness of Judaea and this was his message: 'Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is close at hand.' This was the man the prophet Isaiah spoke of when he said:

A voice cries in the wilderness: Prepare a way for the Lord, make his paths straight.

This man John wore a garment made of camel-hair with a leather belt round his waist, and his food was locusts and wild honey. Then Jerusalem and all Judaea and the whole Jordan district made their way to him, and as they were baptised by him in the river Jordan they confessed their sins. But when he saw a number of Pharisees and Sadducees coming for baptism he said to them, 'Brood of vipers, who warned you to fly from the retribution that is coming? But if you are repentant, produce the appropriate fruit, and do not presume to tell yourselves, "We have Abraham for our father," because, I tell you, God can raise children for Abraham from these stones. Even now the axe is laid to the roots of the trees, so that any tree which fails to produce good fruit will be cut down and thrown on the fire. I baptise you in water for repentance, but the one who follows me is more powerful than I am, and I am not fit to carry his sandals; he will baptise you with the Holy Spirit and fire. His winnowing-fan is in his hand; he will clear his threshing-floor and gather his wheat into the barn; but the chaff he will burn in a fire that will never go out."
